

Australian Nurses Memorial Centre Scholarships

GENERAL INFORMATION 2019

Scholarship Description

The Australian Nurses Memorial Centre (ANMC) is pleased to offer scholarships for nurses and midwives undertaking postgraduate study by course work or research at an Australian university or other accredited higher education institution. The purpose of these scholarships is to increase access to postgraduate study for nurses and midwives as part of the ANMC's mission to act as "a living memorial" by advancing the nursing profession through education.

Scholarships awarded in this round of applications for study in 2020 are:

- The Vivian Bullwinkel Award (value up to AUD \$10,000 maximum)
- The Betty Jeffrey Award (value up to AUD \$8,000 maximum)
- The Anne Murray Mental Health Scholarship (value up to AUD \$5,000 maximum)
- The Indigenous Scholarship for Indigenous Nurses (value up to AUD \$5,000 maximum)
- The Prince Henry's Affiliates Scholarship (value up to AUD \$3,000 maximum)

Study Subject: Related to contemporary nursing or midwifery practice

Level: Postgraduate – Coursework or Research

Eligibility

These scholarships are for study in Australia. They are open to nurses and midwives who are citizens or permanent residents of Australia and hold current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). Payment Information

The scholarships are paid in two instalments (March and June) in the year of study. Research students are required to submit an Academic Progress Report demonstrating satisfactory academic progress in mid May and mid November. For recipients studying by course work a certified copy of the University Transcript is required in July and December.
