### Eligibility Criteria

	Criteria	Y/N
1.	Evidence of current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia is supplied.	
2.	Applicant is of Indigenous or Torres Strait Islander heritage and evidence of Australian citizenship is supplied.	
3.	Level of education activity is Postgraduate.	
4.	Education activity is related to contemporary professional practice in nursing or midwifery.	
5.	An ongoing commitment to professional practice in two or more of the following ways is shown: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Member of a professional nursing association or special interest group.</li><li>• Contributes to the ongoing development of the team in which they work.</li><li>• Actively involved in innovations in professional practice.</li><li>• Recent involvement in research or presentations at conferences.</li><li>• Makes a significant contribution to community service.</li></ul>	
6.	All sections of the Scholarship Application Form are completed.	
7.	The application is received by 31 <sup>st</sup> August, 2021.	
8.	Scholarship application is looked upon favourably if accompanied by completed application form and payment to become a member of the ANMC.
