

ANMC Eligibility Criteria for all Scholarships



1.	You must hold current registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia.
2.	You must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident.
3.	You must be a member of the Australian Nurses Memorial Centre.
4.	Your current or proposed course of study must be at a postgraduate level.
5.	Your current or proposed course of study must be related to contemporary professional practice in nursing or midwifery.
6.	You must demonstrate an ongoing commitment to professional practice through two or more of the following means: • Hold membership of a professional nursing association or special-interest group. • Contribute to the ongoing development of the team in which you work. • Be actively involved in innovation in professional practice. • Show recent involvement in research, e.g. through conference presentation/s. • Demonstrate a significant degree of community service.
7.	You must complete all sections of the scholarship application form.
8.	Study must be undertaken in the scholarship year 2027.
NB	Specific Eligibility Criteria
9.	ALS Scholarship – You must be a current or past member of the Australian Defence Forces (ADF) or have a family member who is a current or past member of the ADF.
10.	Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Nurses Midwife scholarship – You must identify as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person.
11.	Prince Henry's Affiliates Scholarship – You must be resident and practicing in Victoria
12.	Rosemary Norman Foundation – To be eligible for a Rosemary Norman Grant, you must be enrolled or accepted for enrolment in a postgraduate degree. To be eligible for the 'Babe' Norman Scholarship, you must be enrolled or accepted for enrolment as a PhD candidate. Your current or proposed course of study must be related to contemporary professional practice in nursing or midwifery. You must not be in receipt of any other grant or scholarship.

The ANMC selection committee will review all applications and award scholarships based on meeting the eligibility criteria and the strength of each application.
